

The *Athens- Kavala conference in Science and Technology Studies* takes place every year in Kavala, a coastal city in northern Greece, as a joint undertaking of the National Technical University of Athens and the Municipality of Kavala. The idea was initiated by [Maria Rentetzi](#), Associate Professor in History and Sociology of Science and Technology at the NTUA. The goal of this initiative is to be a center for reflection and of passionate discussions on the pivotal role that science and technology have played and still play in our everyday lives.
